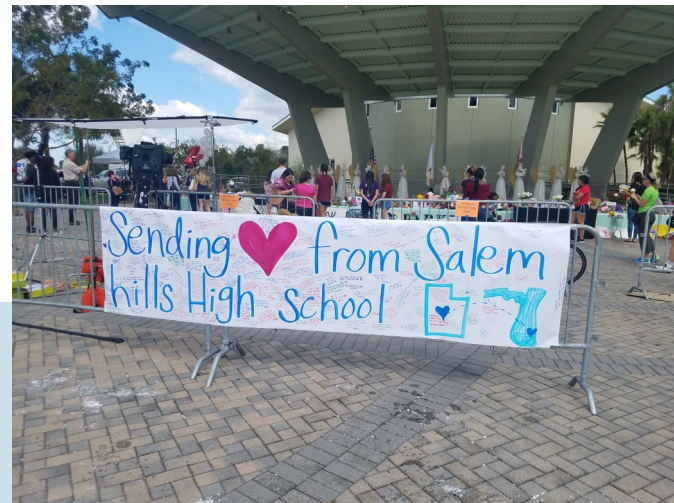
You Made A Difference!

The posters you signed were placed in front of the memorial site for the 17 victims of the Marjorie Stoneman Douglas School in Parkland, Florida. Kathy Christensen, one of our finance office technicians, took the posters with her to Florida. She drove to the school with no idea how or where to deliver the message to MSD students. In her own words, "We approached some police officers and asked them where would be the best place to hang or hand over the posters. I really was amazed how kind and helpful they were considering the chaos and overwhelming sadness their community had recently experienced. . . They directed us to Parkland Park, where a memorial had been set up. We were approached immediately by parents of students from MSD High School. We cried with them as they shared their children's experiences of that tragic day with us. They invited us to their church and prayer service which we graciously accepted. They helped us hang our posters and people immediately swarmed to read the beautiful messages our students wrote."

Several members of the MSD High School community have reached out to thank our school for the act of kindness. In the face of tragedy, your kind words have lifted spirits and let suffering people know you care.

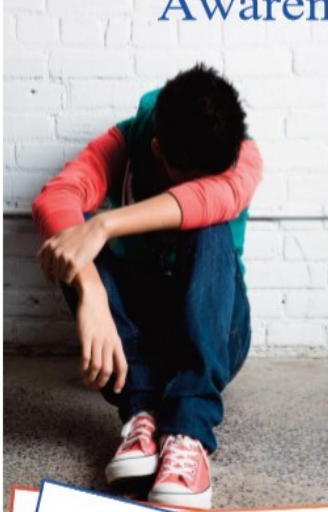

This year each AP exam costs \$98.00.

Online exam registration will end on Wed, Feb 28, 2018 at 11:59 PM.

In order to register, students should click on the link provided on the school website (under the student tab, Look for AP Test Registration) or visit www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/450399.

To complete registration, students must answer all of the required questions. Registration is not complete until students have printed the pdf of the confirmation page that is provided at the end. We strongly recommend that parents and students are both present while registering to ensure that the correct exams are ordered.

Please be sure to have a **credit card or debit card available before beginning registration**. Paying online is a great way to make sure that payment has been made while avoiding mailing the payment.

Here are the important dates for the registration process:

- **Wed, Feb 21, 2018 at 11:59 PM - Registrations and payments after this date will incur a \$10 late fee per registration.**
- **Wed, Feb 28, 2018 at 11:59 PM - Registration ends.**
- **Mon, Mar 5, 2018 at 11:59 PM - Registrations that have not been paid for will be canceled, and exams will not be ordered.**
