ATTENDANCE & ACADEMIC RECOVERY TIME

To excuse a student's absence, please simply reply to the "student attendance" email, OR email the attendance secretary at: attendance-shhs@nebo.edu

*****Parents, all absences and 1st period tardies will need to be excused within 5 school days!*****

Please be sure to include the student's first & last name, student ID number, as well as the date & class periods that you are needing to excuse your student from.

In order for students to remain eligible for school activities, they must remain under the 5 hour threshold.

Students will need to makeup their UNEXCUSED absences and missed academic time by one of the following ways:

- Students may make up their missed class time with their teachers, as scheduled with their teacher.

Invest Nest is an entrepreneurship competition for high school students where students pitch their business ideas to a panel of judges. After three rounds, the winner gets the grand prize of \$10,000.

In simple words, "Shark Tank" for students!

How It Works

- 1st round - 30 second elevator pitch of your business
- 2nd round - 5 minute pitch deck presentation (elimination round)
- Final round - revised pitch deck presentation

Winner of round three will receive \$10,000, and compete at the state competition for a chance to win another \$20,000.

- Final Round, April 18th
- State Final, April 29th

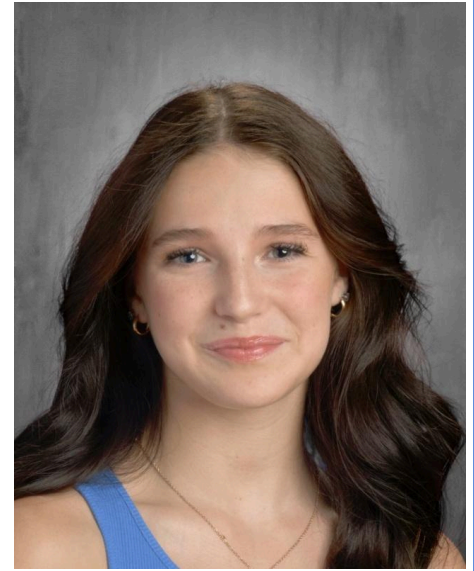

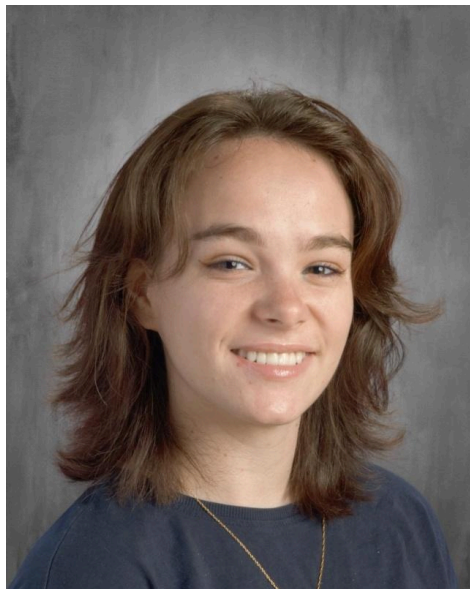
