ATTENDANCE & ACADEMIC RECOVERY TIME

To excuse a student's absence, please simply reply to the "student attendance" email, OR to email the attendance office at: cindie.simmons@nebo.edu. Please be sure to include the student's first & last name, student ID number, as well as the date & class periods that you are needing to excuse your student from.

In order for students to remain eligible for school activities, they must remain under the 20 hour threshold.

Students will need to makeup their UNEXCUSED absences and missed academic time by one of the following ways:

- Students may make up their missed class time with their teachers, as scheduled with their teacher. Serving 45 minutes counts for 1 absence, serving 20 minutes counts for ½ of an absence.





Applying is FREE and easy. It's all done online. High school students must be at least 16 yrs old AND a Junior to apply. First time applicants can only choose "undecided" as a program choice. After your account is created you can then select specific programs.
- Complete Admission Requirements**
Program admission requirements may be met by taking our assessment test in our Testing Center or by bringing qualifying documentation to the testing center or by emailing them to testcenter@mtec.edu. For full information visit mtec.edu/testing
- Complete Program Specific Requirements**
Some programs have prerequisites that must be completed before registration. Find them online for specific programs at mtec.edu/programs. Ex. Must meet with an MTECH counselor for Non Term Programs
