# ATTENDANCE & ACADEMIC RECOVERY TIME

To excuse a student's absence, please simply reply to the "student attendance" email, OR to email the attendance office at: [cindie.simmons@nebo.edu](mailto:cindie.simmons@nebo.edu). Please be sure to include the student's first & last name, student ID number, as well as the date & class periods that you are needing to excuse your student from.

In order for students to remain eligible for school activities, they must remain under the 20 hour threshold.

Students will need to makeup their UNEXCUSED absences and missed academic time by one of the following ways:

- Students may make up their missed class time with their teachers, as scheduled with their teacher. Serving 45 minutes counts for 1 absence, serving 20 minutes counts for ½ of an absence.
- ART (Academic Recovery Time) Labs!
  - Tuesday - Friday Before School: 7:00 – 7:45 a.m. in room D209 with Mrs. Tolbert.
  - Tuesday, Thursday, Friday After School: 2:45 – 3:30 p.m. in room D203 with Mr. VanLeuven.
- Wellness Wednesdays
  - Earn double hours each Wednesday after school from 2:45-3:30pm in room D104 with Corom

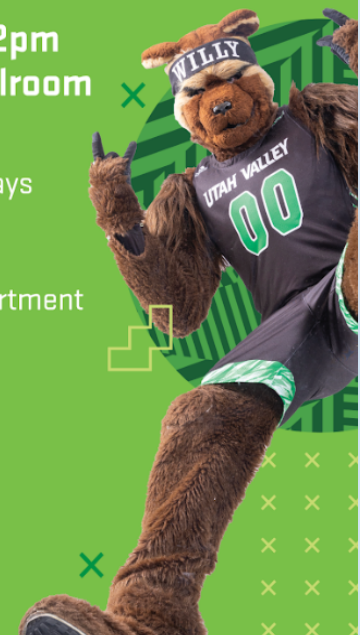
