## ATTENDANCE & ACADEMIC RECOVERY TIME

**\*\*\*Parents, all absences and 1st period tardies will need to be excused within 5 school days!\*\*\***

Please be sure to include the student's first & last name, student ID number, as well as the date & class periods that you are needing to excuse your student from.

**In order for students to remain eligible for school activities, they must remain under the 5 hour threshold.**

Students will need to makeup their UNEXCUSED absences and missed academic time by one of the following ways:

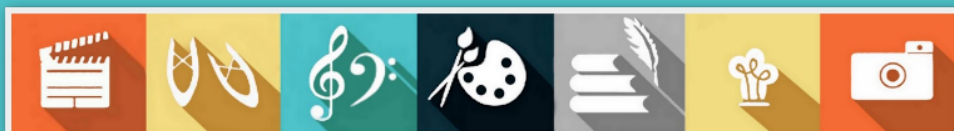

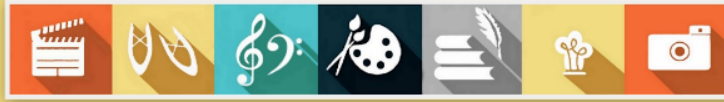
