Friday, May 19th - LAST DAY OF CLASSES FOR SENIORS

If you have received an email saying you have everything turned in with all fines paid and graduation requirements have been met, then your cap, gown and diploma will be available for pick up from 9:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m. in the upper auditorium hallway.

After that they will be available in the counseling center. **We are handing out your Diploma with your cap and gown. Please be careful with your Diploma. We cannot get another one printed for you.** If you can't pick up your cap, gown and diploma on Friday the 19th, we will have them at practice on Monday, May 22, for you to pick up or you can come to the counseling center from 1:00 - 3:00 p.m. that same day.
