With great pleasure, we announce that the Utah Chapter of Freedoms Foundation at Valley Forge will again provide the opportunity for selected 11<sup>th</sup> grade students throughout Utah to attend the 2021 *Spirit of America Youth Conference* at Valley Forge, Pennsylvania.
