AP Exam Registration is Now!

Taking the Advanced Placement exams is an important part of all AP courses. Salem Hills High School desires that all students take AP exams for the AP classes that they have taken. Scoring well on an AP exam can often earn students college credit for their high school class, saving a significant amount on tuition.

For the 2019 AP exams, students at Salem Hills High School will be registering online. This registration will take a few minutes and can be completed from any computer with internet access.

This year each AP exam costs \$98.00. There is a one time fee of 2:00 per student. Salem Hills High School desires that every student be able to take their AP exams.

Online Exam registration will begin on Sat, Dec 29, 2018 at 8:31 AM and end on Wed, Feb 27, 2019 at 11:31 PM. After February 14, 2019 there is an added late fee. In order to register, students should click on the link provide on the school website or visit www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/450399 to register .

To complete registration, students must answer all of the required questions. Registration is not complete until students have printed the pdf of the confirmation page that is provided at the end. We know that parents may desire to register their students for exams. We strongly recommend that parents and students are both present while registering to ensure that the correct exams are ordered.

Salem Hills High School is excited to offer families the convenience of paying exam fees online at the time of registration. Please be sure to have a **credit card or debit card available before beginning registration**. Paying online is a great way to make sure that payment has been made while avoiding mailing the payment.

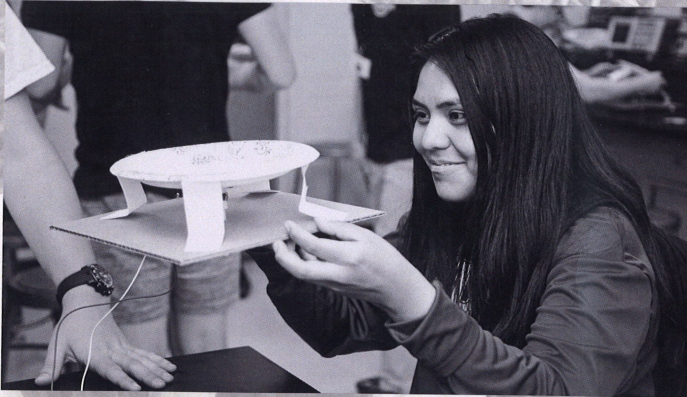
Here are the important dates for the registration process:

- Sat, Dec 29, 2018 at 8:31 AM - Registration Begins
- **Thu, Feb 14, 2019 at 11:59 PM - Registrations and payments after this date will incur a \$20 late fee per exam.**
- **Wed, Feb 27, 2019 at 11:31 PM - Registration Ends**
- Mon, Mar 4, 2019 at 11:31 PM - Registrations that have not been paid for will be cancelled and exams will not be ordered.
- Tue, Mar 5, 2019 - Last day to cancel an exam and receive a full refund.
- Tue, Apr 2, 2019 - Last day to cancel an exam with a cancellation fee of \$25.00.

Last year, 277 high school seniors applied for a Utah CTE Scholarship and Tuition Award, with 105 of the applicants receiving a college scholarship.
