Counselors will be going into English classes on Monday and Tuesday (10/30 and 10/31) to give students a handout to get ready to fill out college applications on Thursday & Friday (Nov. 2 & 3). They will also have information about what to bring to FAFSA Completion Night on Nov. 1st 3pm-8pm.

Students need to know which colleges they want to apply for on Thursday and Friday so they can make the best use of their time and benefit from college reps and counselors who will be there to help. Students should make sure to bring their Social Security Number and Driver's License #. Also bring emergency contact phone and email.

Feel free to wear college gear all week, but especially on **Thursday** and **Friday** to celebrate Utah College Application Week. There will be doughnuts for the senior English class with the most participants (a winner for A day and also B day) and teachers of the winning classes receive a gift card too. Join in the excitement of Utah College Application Week!

FAFSA Completion Night

Nov. 1st 3pm - 8pm.

We want EVERY SENIOR to fill out the FAFSA!

What to bring:

- Social security card, alien registration or permanent resident card
- Driver's license
- 2016 W-2 forms and other records of income
- 2016 Federal Income Tax Return (for you and your spouse)
- Your parents' 2016 Federal Income Tax Return
- Your current bank statements
- Your 2016 untaxed income records
- Your current business & investment mortgage information, business & farm, stock, bond and other investment records

Remember you get a golden ticket just for coming to the event and you will be entered into a drawing to win another scholarship when you complete the FAFSA. Come and be entered into 2 drawings for scholarships in one night! Filling out the FAFSA is one of the first steps for applying for scholarships.




