## COLLEGE APPLICATION WEEK

College Application Week will be October 7-11. All seniors are encouraged to apply to at least one college or university. There will be a FAFSA information night held in the library on **Thursday, October 10 from 3-8 pm**. Counselors will be on hand to help students and parents complete the FAFSA, which stands for Free Application for Federal Student Aid. Many colleges and universities, especially public institutions, require the FAFSA. It must be submitted every year that students hope to receive financial aid.

## SPIRIT OF AMERICA YOUTH CONFERENCE AT VALLEY FORGE

The Utah chapter of Freedoms Foundation at Valley Forge will be providing the opportunity for selected 11th grade students to attend the 2020 Spirit of America Youth Conference at Valley Forge, Pennsylvania. Those students selected may attend one of three sessions: **March 5-8, March 12-15, or April 16-19, 2020**. Students will be required to pay \$400 of the total estimated cost of \$1,200. The four-day conference will include tours of Valley Forge, Independence Hall, Constitution Center, and the Liberty Bell, as well as the chance to interact with students from across the country, college professors, and historical interpreters. The Utah Freedoms Foundation Scholarship Fund will cover the remaining costs of the conference. **Applications must be postmarked no later than Friday, November 22 and mailed to the address listed on the application.**

## What You Will Need to Complete the FAFSA

To complete the 2020-2021 FAFSA, you will need this information:

- Student's and parent(s)' Social Security card, alien registration or permanent resident card
- Student's driver's license (if the student has one)
- Student's and parent(s)' 2018 W-2 form and other records of taxed income\*
- Student's and parent(s)' 2018 Federal Income Tax Return\*\*
- Student's and parent(s)' current bank statements
- Student's and parent(s)' 2018 untaxed income records
- Student's and parent(s)' current business and investment; property mortgage information; business and farm, stock, bond and other investment records\*\*\*

\*If you were gainfully employed

\*\*If you filed an income tax return. IRS 1040 (including any schedules, such as "Schedule 1"), Foreign Tax Return, or Tax Return from Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, the U.S. Virgin Islands, the Marshall Islands, the Federated State of Micronesia, or Palau.

\*\*\*Stocks, bonds, and other investments designated for retirement (such as those found in a 401(k) or IRA) are not reported on the FAFSA. The value of businesses with fewer than 100 FTE employees is also not reported on the FAFSA.

**KEEP THESE RECORDS!** You may need them again. Do NOT mail your records to Federal Student Aid.
