ATTENDANCE & ACADEMIC RECOVERY TIME

To excuse a student's absence, please simply reply to the "student attendance" email, OR email the attendance secretary at: attendance-shhs@nebo.edu

*****Parents, all absences and 1st period tardies will need to be excused within 5 school days!*****

Please be sure to include the student's first & last name, student ID number, as well as the date & class periods that you are needing to excuse your student from.

In order for students to remain eligible for school activities, they must remain under the 5 hour threshold.

Students will need to make up their UNEXCUSED absences and missed academic time by one of the following ways:

- Students may make up their missed class time with their teachers, as scheduled with their teacher.
- Serving 60 minutes counts for 1 absence, and serving 15 minutes counts for 1 tardy.
