ATTENDANCE & ACADEMIC RECOVERY TIME


To excuse a student's absence, please simply reply to the "student attendance" email, OR to email the attendance office at: <u>cindie.simmons@nebo.edu</u>. Please be sure to include the student's first & last name, student ID number, as well as the date & class periods that you are needing to excuse your student from.

In order for students to remain eligible for school activities, they must remain under the 20 hour threshold. Students will need to makeup their UNEXCUSED absences and missed academic time by one of the following ways:


