ATTENDANCE & ACADEMIC RECOVERY TIME

To excuse a student's absence, please simply reply to the "student attendance" email, OR email the attendance secretary at: attendance-shhs@nebo.edu

Parents, all absences and 1st period tardies will need to be excused within 5 school days!

 - Earn double hours each Wednesday after school from 2:30-3:30 p.m. in room D104 with Corom Hughes.






Linden Valgardson
