May 22nd - Graduation Practice at UVU

Graduation practice will be held at 9:30 a.m. at the UCCU Center at UVU. Do not be late! Attendance at the practice is mandatory! Be sure you have checked your seat number and know where to line up when you arrive at the practice. Your seat number is located in your cap and gown packet. Two buses will be available if you need a ride to practice. They will leave the school promptly at 8:45 a.m. Otherwise, you are welcome to drive over. Be safe and buckle up.

May 23rd - Graduation is Tuesday, May 23, at 2:00 p.m. at the UCCU Center at UVU.* Seniors must be lined up in the tunnels at 1:00 p.m. DO NOT BE LATE. MAKE YOURSELF A LIST OF THINGS TO REMEMBER TO BRING...CAP, GOWN,TASSEL and HONOR CORD, ETC. This is a great accomplishment for you and your family. Please wear your best dress and help make it a great experience for everyone involved. Gowns must be zipped up. Caps cannot be decorated.

ATTENDANCE & ACADEMIC RECOVERY TIME

To excuse a student's absence, please simply reply to the "student attendance" email, OR to email the attendance office at: cindie.simmons@nebo.edu. Please be sure to include the student's first & last name, student ID number, as well as the date & class periods that you are needing to excuse your student from.

In order for students to remain eligible for school activities, they must remain under the 20 hour threshold.

Students will need to makeup their UNEXCUSED absences and missed academic time by one of the following ways:

- Students may make up their missed class time with their teachers, as scheduled with their teacher. Serving 45 minutes counts for 1 absence, serving 20 minutes counts for $\frac{1}{2}$ of an absence.


