Online Registration

Registration is a 2 part process: 1) Complete your online registration. 2) Pay applicable school fees. The following links will take you to the registration and fees sites. Please complete both as soon as you are able.

Student Schedules

Schedules will be available to view for students who have completed their registration and paid fees on August 5th. Students who need to make class change requests will need to follow directions from the email coming out July 31 from the counselors. Parking

Parking Passes are available and required to park in the student parking areas. [Parking passes](#) are \$10.00 and may be purchased through My School Fees, or in person at the finance office. Lockers

Lockers are available for all students. Lockers are assigned to students upon request only. Any student who chooses to use a locker may request one in the main office. This may be done anytime, or during the open house on August 12th.

Chromebooks

At Salem Hills High School we are a 1:1 school. This means all students will be issued a chromebook for school use. Please keep them charged and bring them to school each day. Sophomore students will have a Chromebook checked out to them at the beginning of the year. Juniors, Seniors, and new students to Salem Hills who checked their Chromebook in or do not have one, will also receive a Chromebook. Students who kept their Chromebook (which is most Juniors and Seniors) please dust them off, charge them up, and bring them ready to use the first day of school.

These Chromebooks will be the student's for the remainder of their high school career. Students should take care of their Chromebooks and charge them each night for school use. Students are also responsible for any negligent damage that may occur to a Chromebook. Parents who choose to insure their student's Chromebook may do so at a cost of \$30.00, and it may be paid along with registration fees. Insurance is strongly recommended and covers student Chromebooks that are damaged; however, it does not cover lost or stolen Chromebooks.

School Lunch

The National School Lunch Program waiver that provided free meals to students has expired. This means that school meals will no longer be automatically free. Breakfast is \$1.50 per serving and Lunch is \$2.50 per serving.

Students & parents looking to qualify for free or reduced-price meals for the 2024-202 school year will need to submit a Meal Benefits Application. Qualification criteria are based on income, household

size, participation in assistance programs such as SNAP, FDPIR, and TANF, as well as living situations such as homelessness and migrancy.

You may access an application by going to your [Infinite Campus Menu](#) then scrolling down to “More” and clicking on “Meal Benefits”. As a reminder, households must apply every year to confirm eligibility for free or reduced-price meals.

Picture Day: August 12th.

All students should plan on getting their picture taken. We use student pictures to make students’ I.D. cards, update iCampus records for teachers, as well as use the students’ pictures for our yearbook. Students will come in before school starts on August 12th. (The photographers will be available from 8:00 AM - 6:00 PM) Pictures will be taken on the stage in the auditorium.

Picture Make-up day is on August 19th - For those who can’t make the 12th we will again have a chance to do a picture during school on August 19th from 7:30 AM - 12 PM.

Picture Retake Day will be held on October 10th. -For those who can’t make the 12th or 19th, the last chance for school pictures will be during school on October 10th from 7:30 AM - 12 PM.

Salem Hills uses the Lifetouch company for school photos and id cards. Here is a link to their website for information if parents would like to purchase picture packets, etc. School ID cards are included in the student body school fee for students. (No purchase necessary)
